The trial court did not abuse its discretion in concluding that R.C. 2953.36(F) did not operate to bar Appellee's application to seal the record of his conviction for pandering obscenity. The trial court did not err in determining that the victim was not a minor at the time the photograph of her was published. Therefore, Appellee was not precluded from eligibility to have his record of conviction sealed.
